

2 Day PADI Open Water Referral Course

Valid 01 July 2018 to 31 March 2019

For those who have already completed their pool & theory component of their PADI dive course, Tusa Dive can complete their dive training with our two day PADI Open Water Referral Courses.

The course requires participants to join TUSA 6 for two single day tours, to complete the four required training dives and acquire their PADI Open Water Certification. An additional two pleasure dives are included, to make a total of 6 dives over the two days.

Each day TUSA will visit two unique outer reef destinations, selected as the best for the days' weather conditions. Skills review with the PADI Instructor will be undertaken on the way to the reef, and three training dives will be undertaken on the first day. The course will be completed after the first dive on Day Two, with two pleasure dives to be enjoyed as a Certified Diver.

Course Cost: AU\$700.00

Course Commences: Mondays, Thursdays, and Saturdays.

Requirements: Min age 12 years, Ability to swim, Speak & understand English

Departs each day: 8.00am from A Finger, Cairns Marlin Marina. Boarding at 07.40am.

Things to bring:

- The Referral paperwork issued by the PADI Dive Instructor who completed the pool and theory training.
- Two passport photos
- Swimmers, hat, towel, change for soft drinks and reef levy.

Medical Information

Prior to commencing the PADI referral participants are required to complete the self-assessment [Entry Level Student Dive Medical Declaration](#). A positive response to any question means that there is a pre-existing condition that may affect their safety while diving and they must consult a medical practitioner preferably with experience in diving medicine to obtain a dive medical certificate stating they are fit to undertake recreational diver training.

Cancellation Policy

There is no charge for cancellations with more than 24 hours notice. 100% charge applies for cancellations with less than 24 hours notice
